



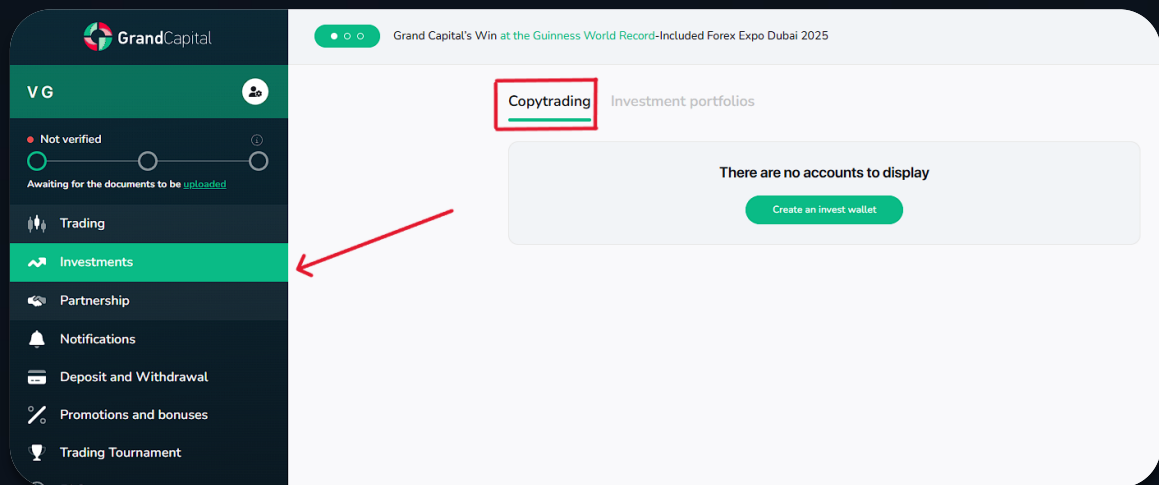
Guide for Managers: GC Invest Copy Trading Service

Copytrading is a service that automatically copies trades. It generates passive income for investors, and enables managers to earn above their own trading.

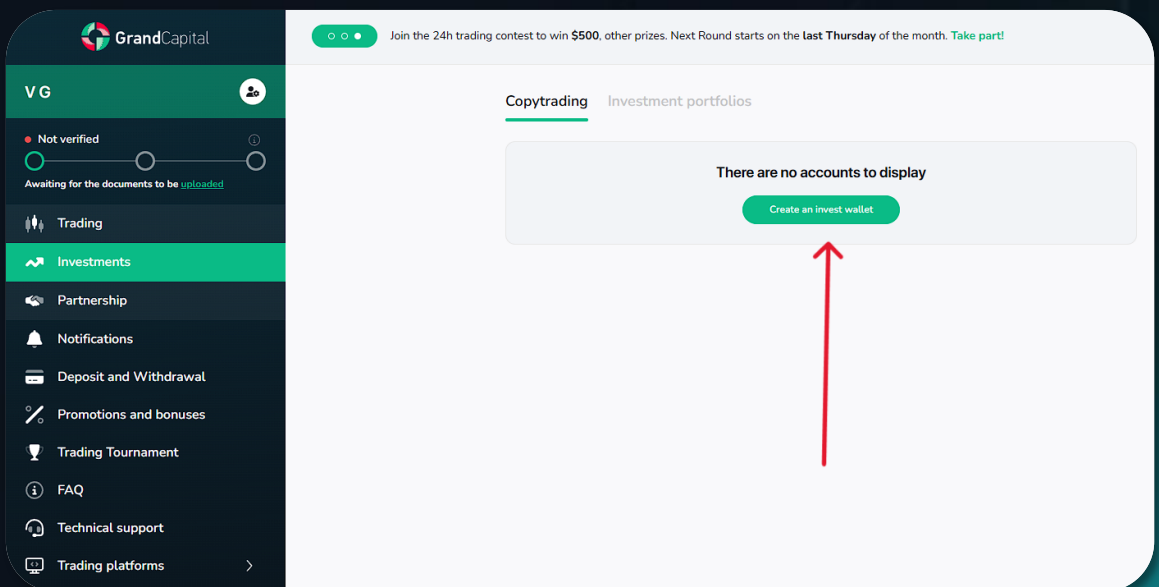
The service is user-friendly: **managers create trading strategies**, and **investors select and invest in the strategies they like**. The copy trading service then automatically copies the manager's trades. In turn, the manager receives a percentage of the profit generated for investors as a reward.

How to Start Investing

Go to the **Private Office**, and open the **Investments** tab. Then, click on **Copytrading**:



Then, click the **Create an Investment Wallet** button:

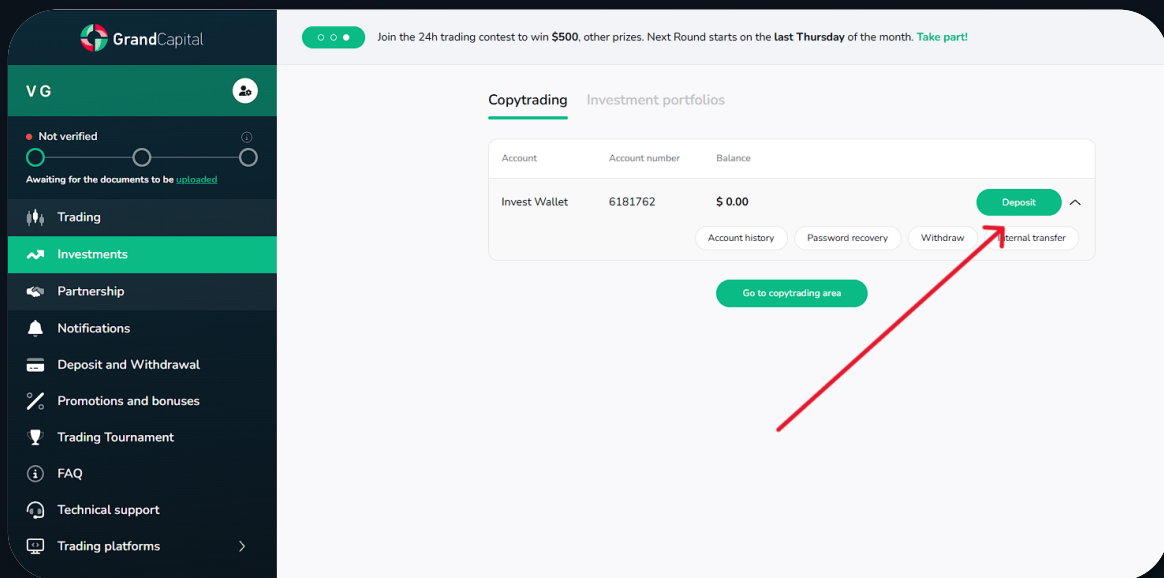


The **Wallet**, or Invest Wallet account, is your gateway to trading in the GC Invest system, whether you are a manager or an investor.

With the Wallet, you can manage all balance operations, including deposits and withdrawals, investing and reinvesting in trading strategies, and internal transfers between trading accounts and investment accounts.

How to Deposit to an Invest Wallet

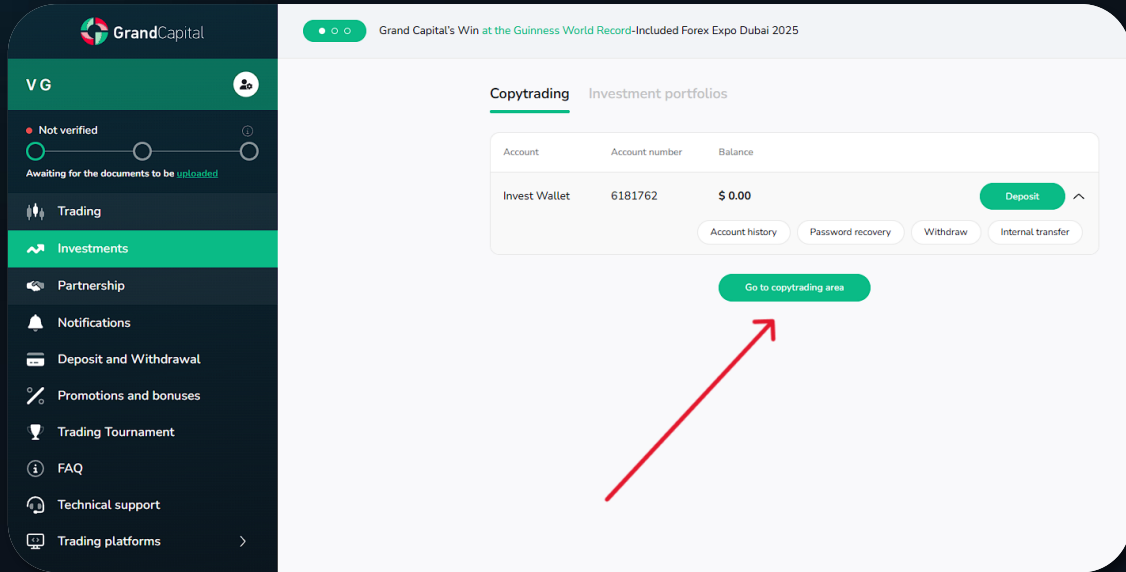
Press the **Deposit** button and select the deposit method that you prefer. The minimum deposit amount required to use the system is 100 USD:

The Copy Trading Area

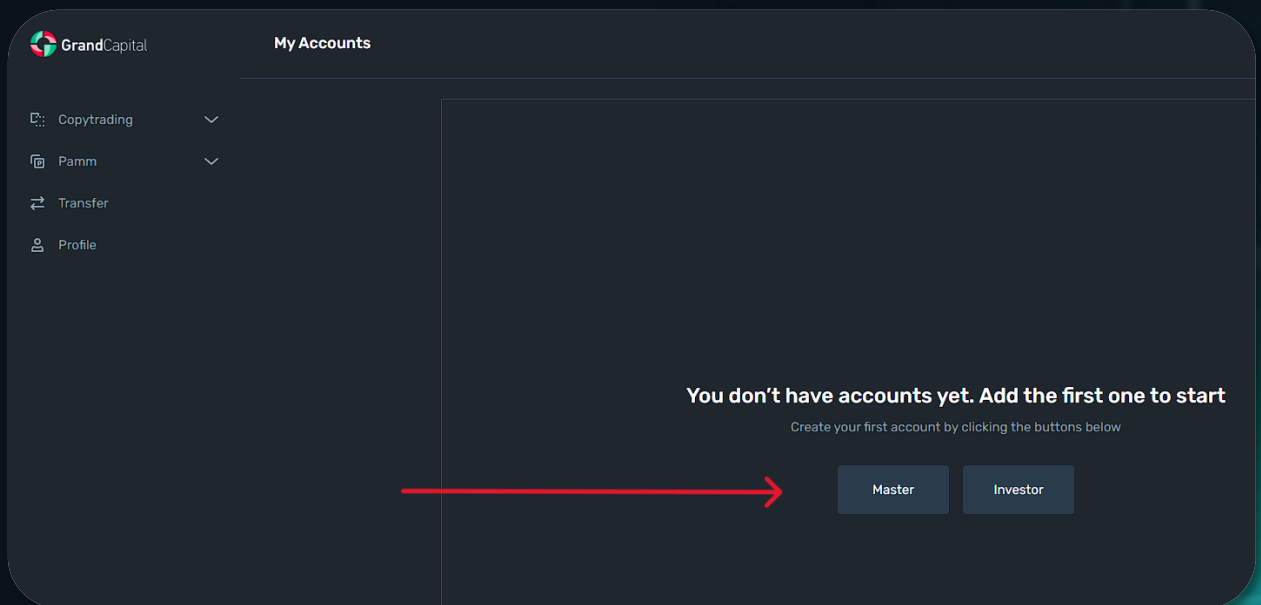
To enter the copy trading area, press the **Go to copytrading area** button. This button will appear below your wallet after it is created:



The **My Accounts** page lists all your accounts related to the service. You can also find information about your Invest Wallet there.

Open a Master Account

On the main page of the service, click at the **Master** button:

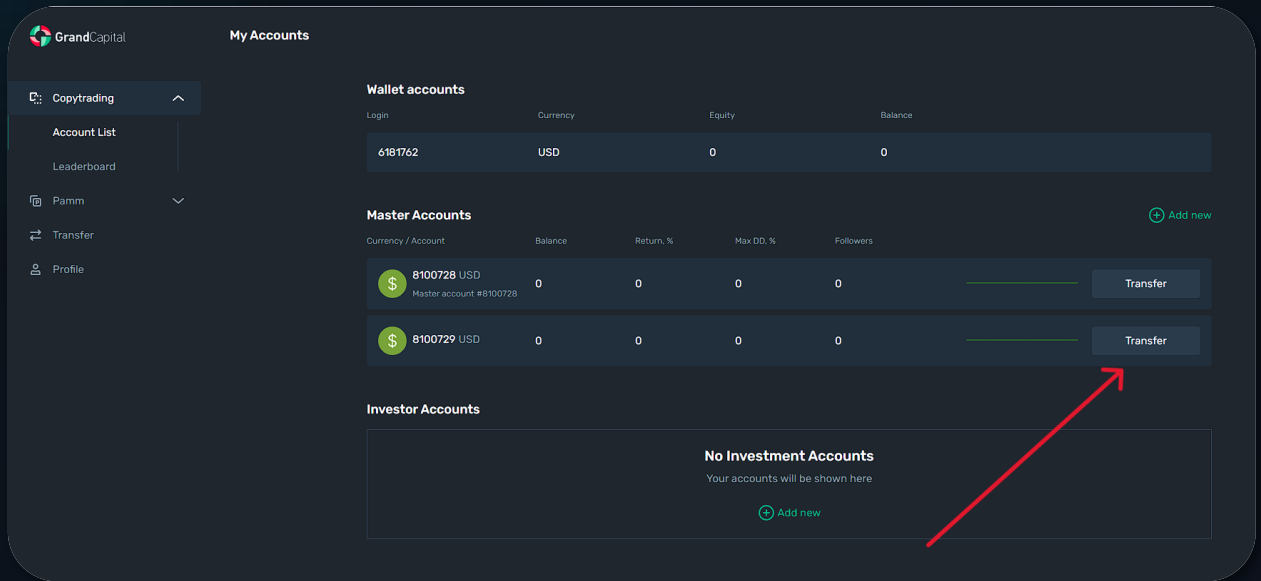

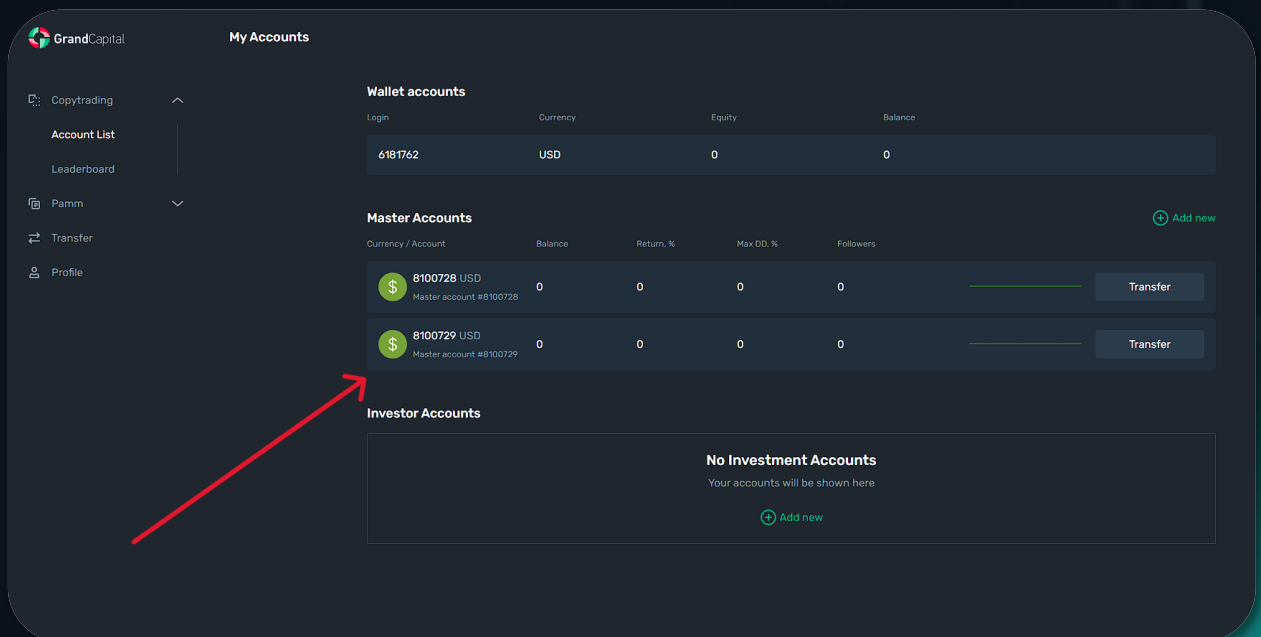

When your account is created, a card with its details will appear on the screen, along with a prompt to proceed to the next step — funding the account. Funding is done through your **Invest Wallet**. Click **Transfer** to continue:



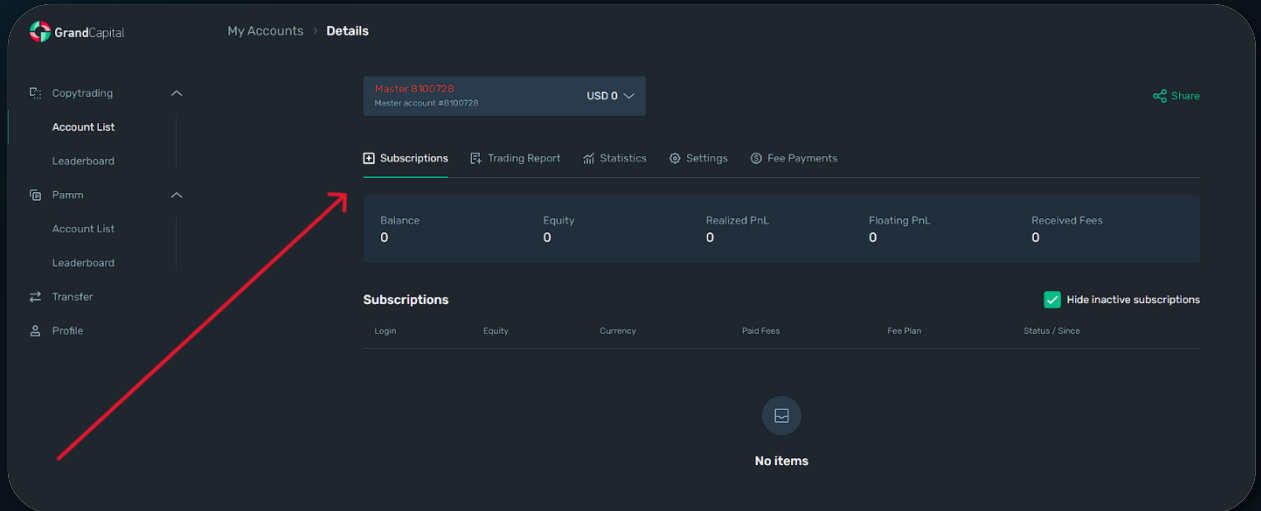
Account Menu

To open the menu, click at the account card. This will give you access to account management options.



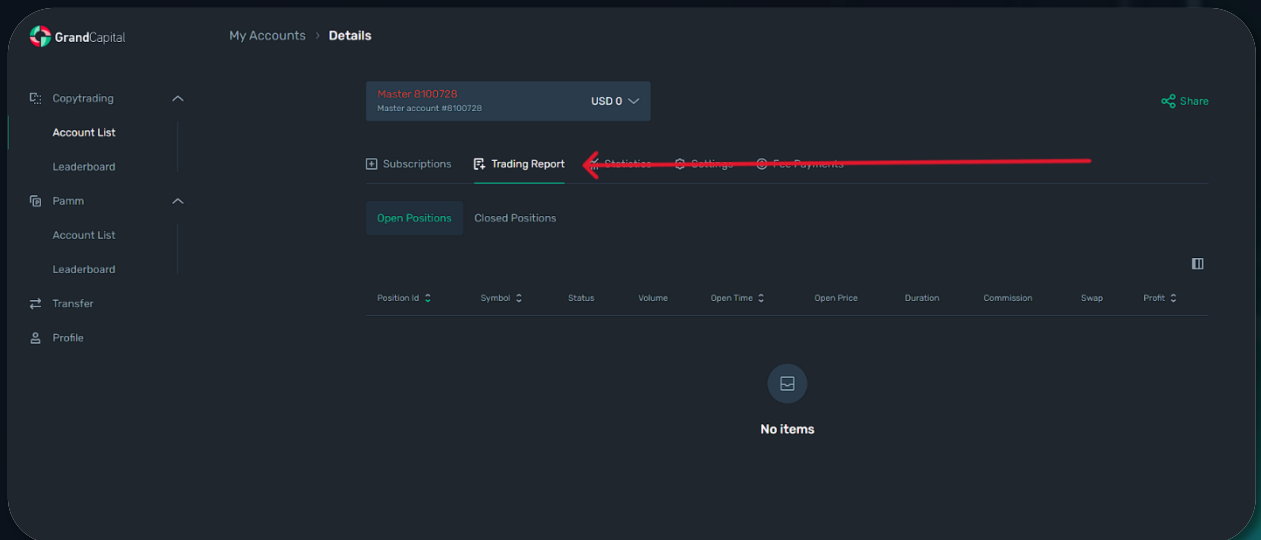
Subscriptions Tab

Here you can see a list of investors connected to your account, as well as information about each investor's account, such as: **Login, Equity, Currency, Paid Fees, Fee Plan and Status.**



Trading Report Tab

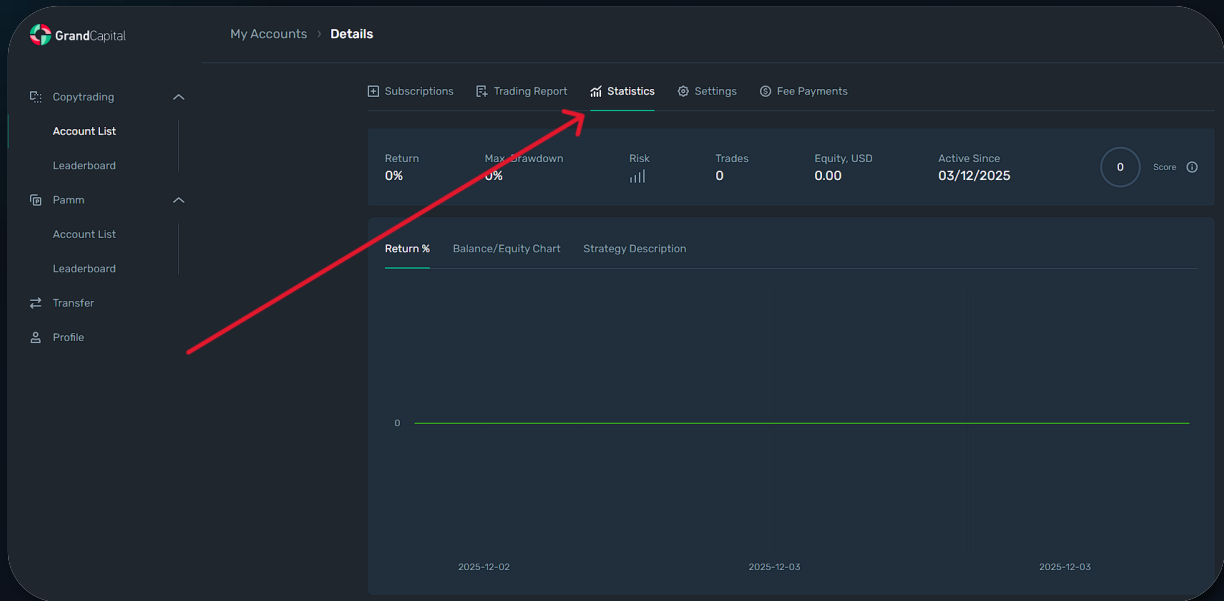
The **Trading Report** tab provides a detailed overview of all your trading activity. Here you can monitor your **open and closed positions**, along with key data such as **Position ID, symbol, status, volume, open time, open price, duration, commission, swap, and profit.**



Statistics Tab

In this tab, you can view full statistics for your account, including:

- **Return %**
- **Equity Chart**
- **Trading Instruments etc.**



You can also share a link to your strategy with potential investors by pressing the button **Share**.

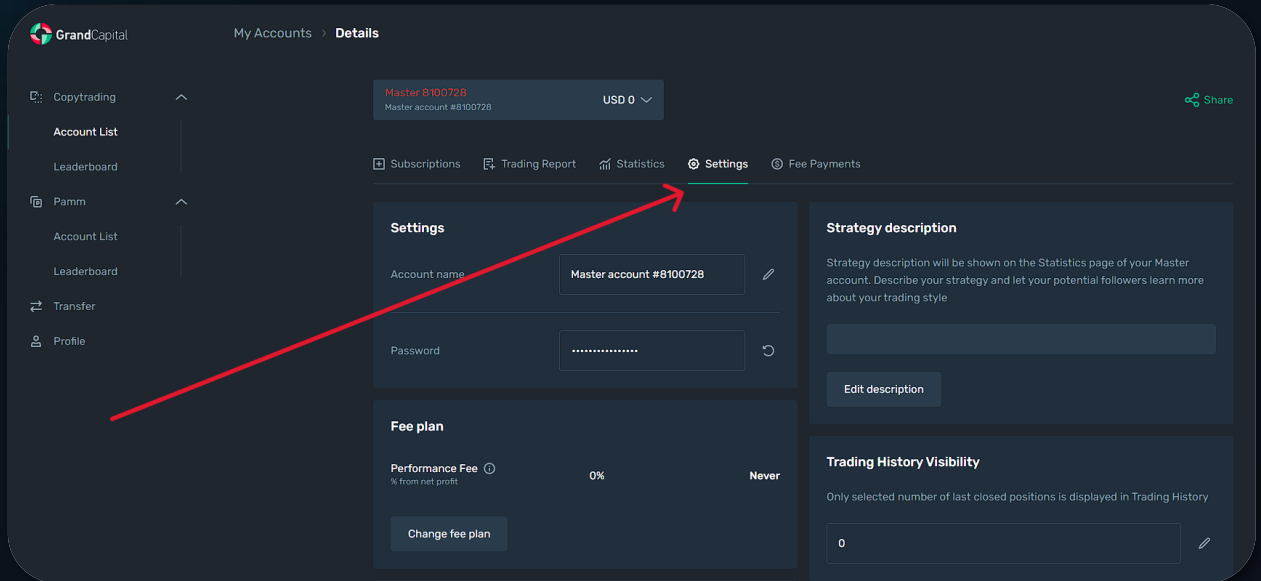

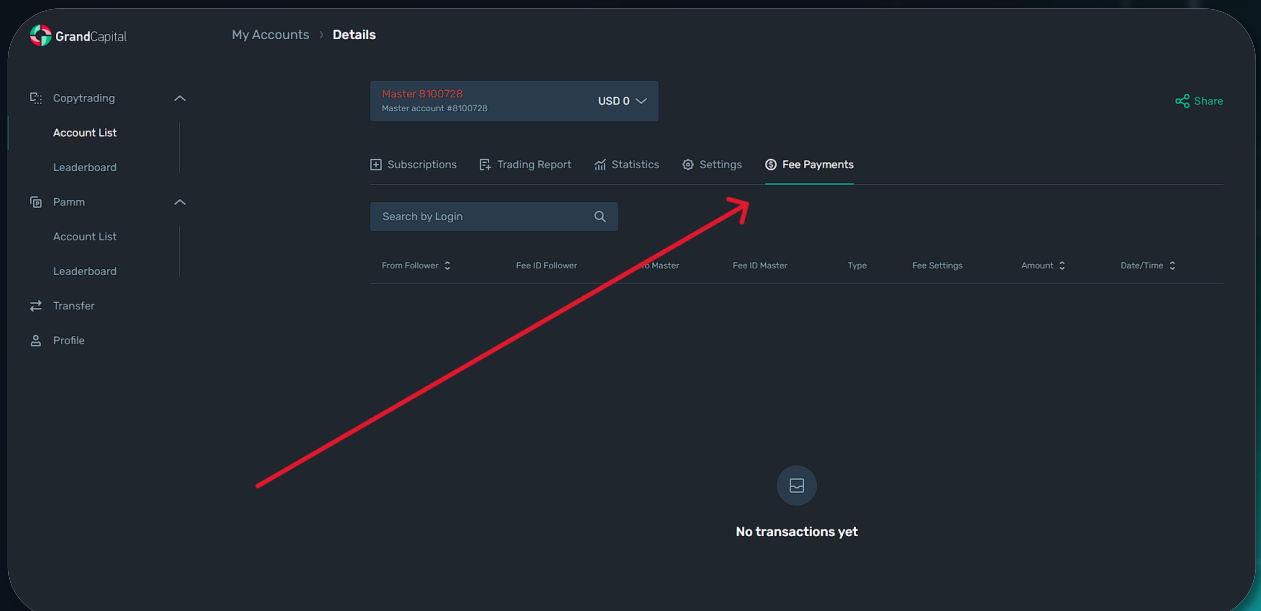
Settings Tab

This tab allows you to manage all key parameters of your master account. Here you can change your **account name**, update your **password**, and customize your **fee plan**. You can also adjust your account's **privacy status**, set a **subscription code** for accessing hidden accounts, and define the **minimum deposit**. Additionally, you can add a **strategy description** that will appear on your Statistics page, control **trading history visibility**, and create **promo offers**.



Fee Payments Tab

The **Fee Payments** tab shows all transactions related to performance fees between you and your followers. Here you can track payments **from the follower to the master**, including details such as **Fee ID (Follower and Master)**, **fee type**, **applied fee settings**, **amount**, and **date/time** of each payment.



Managers provide access to copying their trades in exchange for a fee charged from the investor's profit. Each manager sets their own fee within the range of 0% to 70%.

You can choose from three payout frequency options:

- Daily payouts

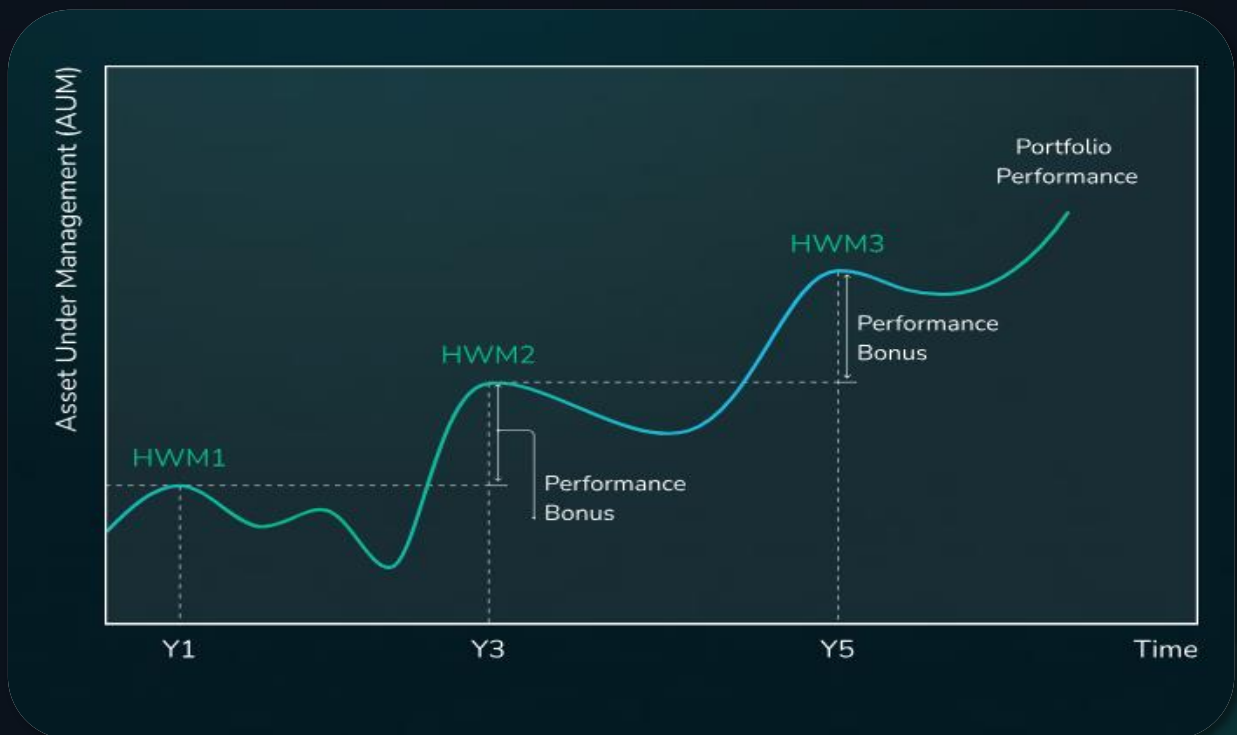
- Weekly payouts
- Monthly payouts

Daily payouts are made at midnight (terminal time), weekly payouts on Saturdays, and monthly payouts on the 1st day of each month.

If you change the payout method, the new conditions will only apply to investors who connect after the change.

The manager's fee is calculated using the High-Water Mark (HWM) system: the manager receives a fee only from the investor's net profit.

High-water mark (HWM)



High-water Mark (HWM) is a reward system where the manager receives their fee only when they generate net profit for the investor. HWM is calculated for each investor individually.

When an investor connects to your strategy, the system automatically sets the first HWM level equal to their initial investment.

You, as the manager, trade using your strategy. At the end of the first trading period, the system automatically checks the investor's **Equity** and **Balance** to calculate your fee. The fee is paid only if both values are above the first HWM level.

If the HWM check is successful, the system subtracts the previous HWM level from the investor's current balance — this difference is the investor's profit for the trading period. Your fee is then deducted from this profit.

The new HWM level becomes the investor's balance after the fee is paid.

Example:


The investor makes an initial deposit of 1000 USD. After one trading period, their balance is 1100 USD. The manager's fee is 30%. Equity is above 1000 USD. The manager receives a 30 USD fee, and the HWM level updates to 1070 USD. For the next payout, both Equity and Balance must exceed 1070 USD at the end of the next period. If either value is below this level, no fee is paid — and will not be paid until both are above 1070 USD.

This calculation applies individually to each investor. If multiple investors join your strategy, each of them pays a fee from their profit, significantly increasing your total earnings.

Leaderboard

Your master account appears in the ranking immediately after it is created. You can access the leaderboard from your profile.

Use the **Find account by login** button to locate your strategy.
